- 6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 1:00 PM on 2081/04/06 at the office of Training Hall, Karmachari Sanchaya Kosh, Pulchowk, Lalitpur. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 of days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs 50,000.00 (Fifty Thousand Only), which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
